When in the marketplace to acquire a pallet lift, it is necessary to determine how the device will be used. In a facility where overhead jacks are currently installed, a pallet haul accessory that functions with the existing devices may be a wise option. If the plant has narrow aisles, selecting a pallet haul that will be maneuverable in the aisles and has a narrow profile might be the best option.
