Normally, the crane comes outfitted along with a hoist, sheaves, and chains or wire ropes. Cranes are utilized in the businesses of construction, transport and manufacturing. These machinery help with the loading and unloading of freight, the movement of supplies, and the assembling of heavy machinery.

There are several different types of cranes in operation, meant specifically for certain applications. The smallest crane, the Jib crane, is designed to be used indoors. The tallest type is the Tower crane, used for constructing buildings. Mini-cranes are utilized to be ale to access tight spaces. Floating cranes are used on water for salvaging operation and oil rig construction.

In the crane training course session, daily crane operating procedures will be reviewed. Course content covers the implementation of correct overhead material handling measures. Correct training means longer equipment lifespan and less maintenance costs. The course instructs individuals participating in inspection and operating methods focused on all operational aspects, such as proper slinging and rigging. Participants could deal with vital crane components to know the mechanical components. Lifting practices will be demonstrated along with suggested procedures for review by your safety committee. Sessions will feature demonstration videos. The crane training course includes a reference and resource manual.

The content of the course will include machinery terms; codes about overhead cranes, proper inspection ways; hoists and attachments; proper sling use; essential maintenance requirements and procedures.
