Forklift Training Tips

The following checklist is important for whatever workplace which has forklifts on the premises. Each of these questions must be answered with "yes" if all the safety regulations and rules are being followed. A "no" to whichever question indicates a procedural flaw that can result in damage to machinery, accident or injury.

- 1) Is the pedestrian traffic separated from the forklift working area?
- 2) Is pedestrian access to forklift travel areas restricted by barriers?
- 3) The pedestrian walkways well-marked?
- 4) A sign is clearly visible stating a "forklift in operation"?
- 5) There are mirrors provided at blind spots for operators and pedestrians?
- 6) Changes or alterations to the daily lift truck schedule has been communicated to workers?
- 7) The lift truck tires being used are suitable for all operating surfaces?
- 8) Forklift seatbelt is being used?
- 9) Is the seat in good condition?
- 10) Is a regular forklift maintenance schedule adhered to?
- 11) Is an annual forklift inspection and certification carried out?
- 12) Is the kind of forklift appropriate for the tasks?
- 13) Is there a readable load chart on the forklift?
- 14) Could the operators understand and read the load chart?
- 15) The chart lists the safe lifting capacity for all attachments and their uses?
- 16) Are the warning devices on the forklift working correctly?
- 17) Is the operating speed control device fitted correctly?
- 18) The forklift overhead cage is fitted correctly?
- 19) Have all lift truck operators acquired certification?
- 20) Speed limits and warning signs are being observed?
- 21) Are forklift operators up to date on training for all types of lift trucks being utilized?
- 22) Forklift operators understand their responsibilities to report the damage to the machine and other lift truck accidents?
- 23) Is the pre-test checklist reviewed daily prior to the machine being operated?
