Due to the many activities involved within warehouse operations, employees in warehouse environment may be at greater risk for accidents than people who work in areas with more limited activities. Hence, businesses prioritize warehouse safety.

Knowledge of potential warehouse dangers is key to preventing accidents. Always be alert to possible dangers and ways to reduce risks. Do whatever is needed to avoid accidents.

General Hazards

Common kinds of danger in a warehouse setting are trips, falls and slips. These accidents are usually caused when staff lose their balance or stumble over a thing that has not been put away properly. Removing or placing things from storage can result in a slip or fumble, possibly resulting in both worker and item to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when workers are moving supplies on different types of floor surfaces and on different levels. Another common hazard is getting hit by falling objects. This is normally caused by failure to correctly stack items on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of incorrect lifting techniques are one more common hazard.

There are inherent risks in utilizing and working around workplace machines. Accidents can often be caused from the improper use of hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors. Warehouse tools, such as pallets, skids, cutting and strapping tools, should be used carefully during unpacking, packing and loading.

Materials which are dangerous, flammable or combustible present another kind of workplace danger while being stored in a warehouse. Workers must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health hazards when working around hazardous materials.
