The theory topics include: Safety fundamentals for crane operators; introduction to crane certification process; rigging knowledge; crane operation knowledge; load chart knowledge; crane rigging charts; crane pre-trip inspections & set-up, and crane maintenance and service.

Practical Programs

The practical training part of the crane training school emphasizes hands-on learning. This part of the course focuses on the identification and terminology of crane components. Trainees will have the opportunity to practice skills required for crane signaling, operating and signaling.

The topics covered in the practical portion includes: Identify crane functions and components; Learn crane terminology; identify wire ropes and rigging; utilize remote control; identify regulations and documents for wire rope and rigging; pre-use inspection on crane; perform rigging methods; use radio and hand signals; and carry out correct lifting and lowering of loads.
