All aspects of forklift handling are included in training programs. The limits and abilities of the machine are included, along with pre-operation checks, basic operating procedures and ways of warning other workers that a forklift is in the work area.

Lessons consist of the placement of the trailer tires and chock blocks, the arrangement of pallets to spread out the load right, and checks required prior to driving into a trailer at a dock site. Courses also include Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) training. Though not related directly to the utilization of a forklift, MSDS training is important if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on individuals and right methods of dealing with spills.
