The telehandler or also known as a telescopic handler is similar in various ways to a crane and a common forklift. This helpful machinery is constructed with a telescopic boom that could lift upwards and extend forward. Different attachments could be connected on the end of the boom, like bucket, pallet forks, lift table or muck grab. It is popular in industry and agriculture settings.

The telehandler is a common used along with fork attachments to allow the shuttling of loads. Telehandlers have the advantage of being able to reach those inaccessible places that can't be reached by a common forklift. Telehandlers are capable of removing loads which are palletized from inside a trailer and placing them on high places such as rooftops. For certain applications, they could be a lot more practical and efficient than a crane.

The disadvantage of the telehandler is its unsteadiness when lifting heavier loads. When the boom extends with a load, the unit becomes more and more unstable. Counterweights found at the back help, but don't solve the problem. The lifting capacity rapidly decreases when the working radius increases. Various machinery come along with front outriggers which extend the lifting capacity when the equipment is stationary.
